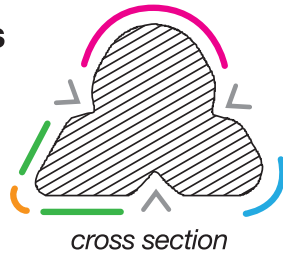

FEATURES

Versatile with 3 types of R-curves

Three types of R-curved, flat, and V-groove sections are available for sharpening various shapes of blades, including straight harvesting shears as well as pruning shears with curved blades.



cross section

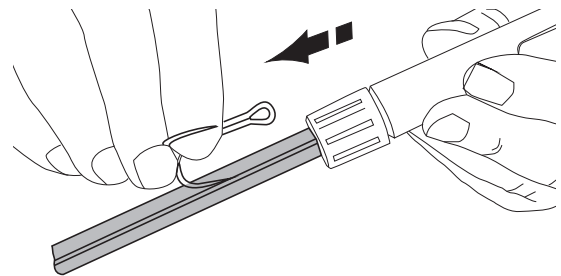
- R(L) Flat

Flat: Upper edge sharpening

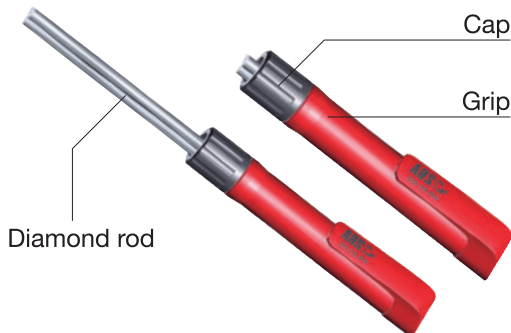


R: Receiving edge sharpening



Easy to store and carry

Compact with pen-shaped design. Easy to store and carry.



The flat part of the diamond rod can be used for the upper blade of pruning shears and knives, the R part for the receiving blade of pruning shears and serrated knives, and the V-groove part for the tips of fish hooks and eyeleters.

USAGE

1) Bring out the diamond rod

Loosen the cap at the opening, let out an appropriate amount of diamond rod, and tighten the cap until it stops moving.

2) Sharpen

Hold the grip firmly with one hand, the tool with the other, and begin sharpening.

3) Remove dirt

After use, rinse with water to remove dirt from diamond rods and wipe dry.

4) Storing diamond rods

Loosen the cap at the opening, push the diamond rod back into the grip, and tighten the cap until it stops moving.
